Ann felt that the project should be done in phases with the HVAC and codes as phase one, followed by the renovation of the basement. She congratulated us on how well the building had been maintained thus far. The next step in this process will be educating the towns people on what our plans are and getting their feedback and support, since grants typically cover only 10% of the total cost of a project, it will be important to have the support of the town for further fundraising. Ann gave us numerous names of towns that have taken on such projects and felt it a good idea to call the managers of the towns for information on how they went about fundraising.
